Based on Romans 10:9–10, 13 (KJV)

“...if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved... For whosoever shall call upon the name of the Lord shall be saved.”

THE PRAYER

Repeat this prayer while picturing Jesus standing in front of you:

Father God,

I come to You in the name of Jesus. I receive Your unconditional love for me. Thank You for loving me so much that You gave Your only Son to die so I can be saved. Today, I confess and accept Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior.

I repent and turn away from all my sins. I humble myself before You and renounce every form of pride in my heart. Your Word says You resist the proud, but give grace to the humble—so I choose humility, repentance, and surrender.

Father, according to Your Word, I thank You for cleansing me from all unrighteousness. In the name of Jesus, I renounce and release every weight of guilt, shame, self-blame, condemnation, and self-criticism. I declare that I am forgiven, redeemed, and made righteous through the blood Jesus shed on the cross.

I am a new creation in Christ—old things have passed away, and all things are made new. Thank You, Father, for saving me, healing me, and making me Yours.

Amen.
